- No registrations will be accepted after 12:15 p.m.
- Formation of Parade:
 - ♦ All divisions will form at fairgrounds gate and proceed down main walk to stage.
 - ♦ All awards will be presented on stage.

RULES

- 1. In all divisions, the decoration subject, theme, and costumes worn only by child or children taking part will be considered by the judges. No adults in costume.
- 2. Any child up to and including first grade may compete, but the chairperson of the parade reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 3. The judges' decisions will be final, based on workmanship and originality.
- 4. Entries will be accepted at registration table from 11:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. the day of the event. **No entries will be accepted after 12:15 p.m.!**
- 5. The distribution or throwing of any articles such as candy, etc. and the use of animals is **FORBIDDEN**.
- 6. No motorized vehicles are permitted to pull floats or any other entry. *Manpower* only. All entries must be pulled across stage. Manpower vehicles can be no larger than 3'x5'x6'.
- 7. Participants may enter in ONE DIVISION and ONE CLASS ONLY.
- 8. Division and class entries with more than one child in the group will receive only one trophy the day of the event; any additional trophy(ies) will be ordered as necessary after the event.
